...but people find it more difficult to live and act together than before

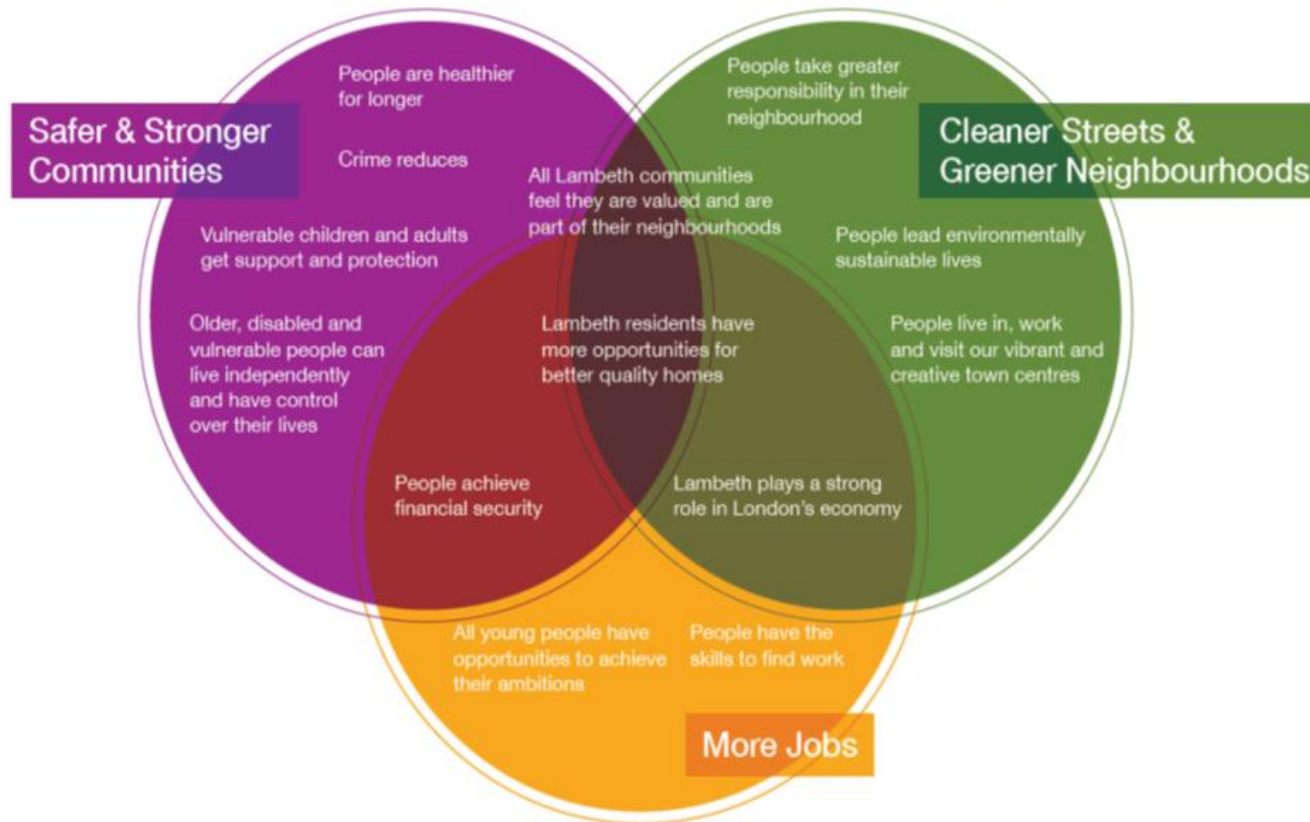


We have a clear strategic vision and direction of travel for the organisation

We want to continue to deliver good services within our budgets

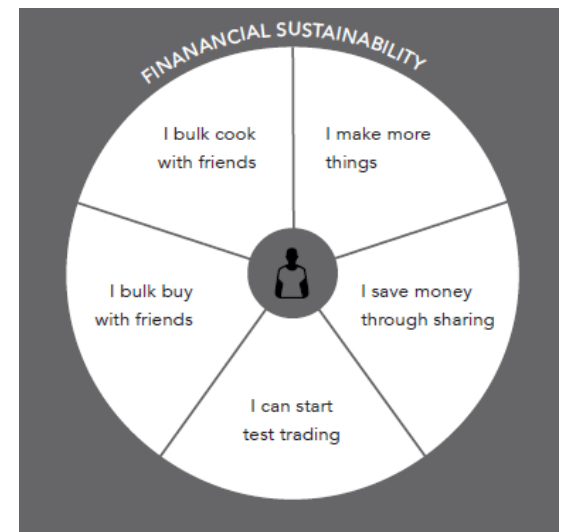
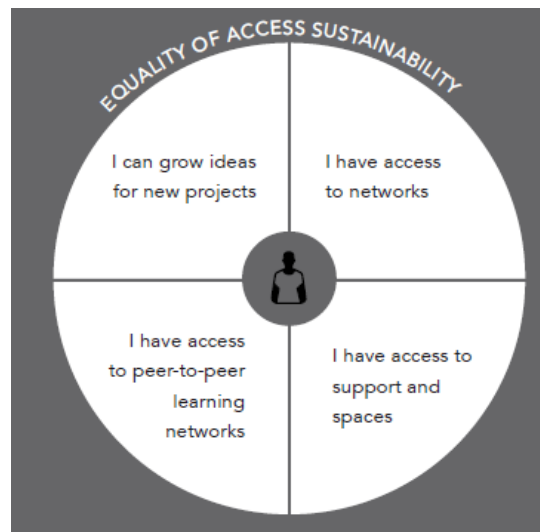
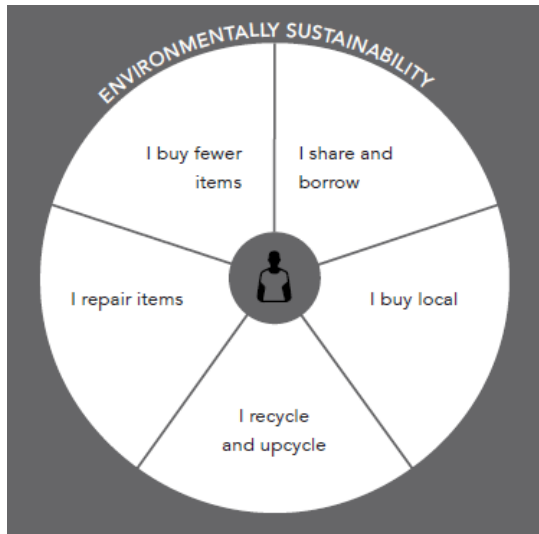


Equality: continuing to protect those who need it most

Resilience: helping to grow strong and supportive communities to tackle issues and take greater responsibility

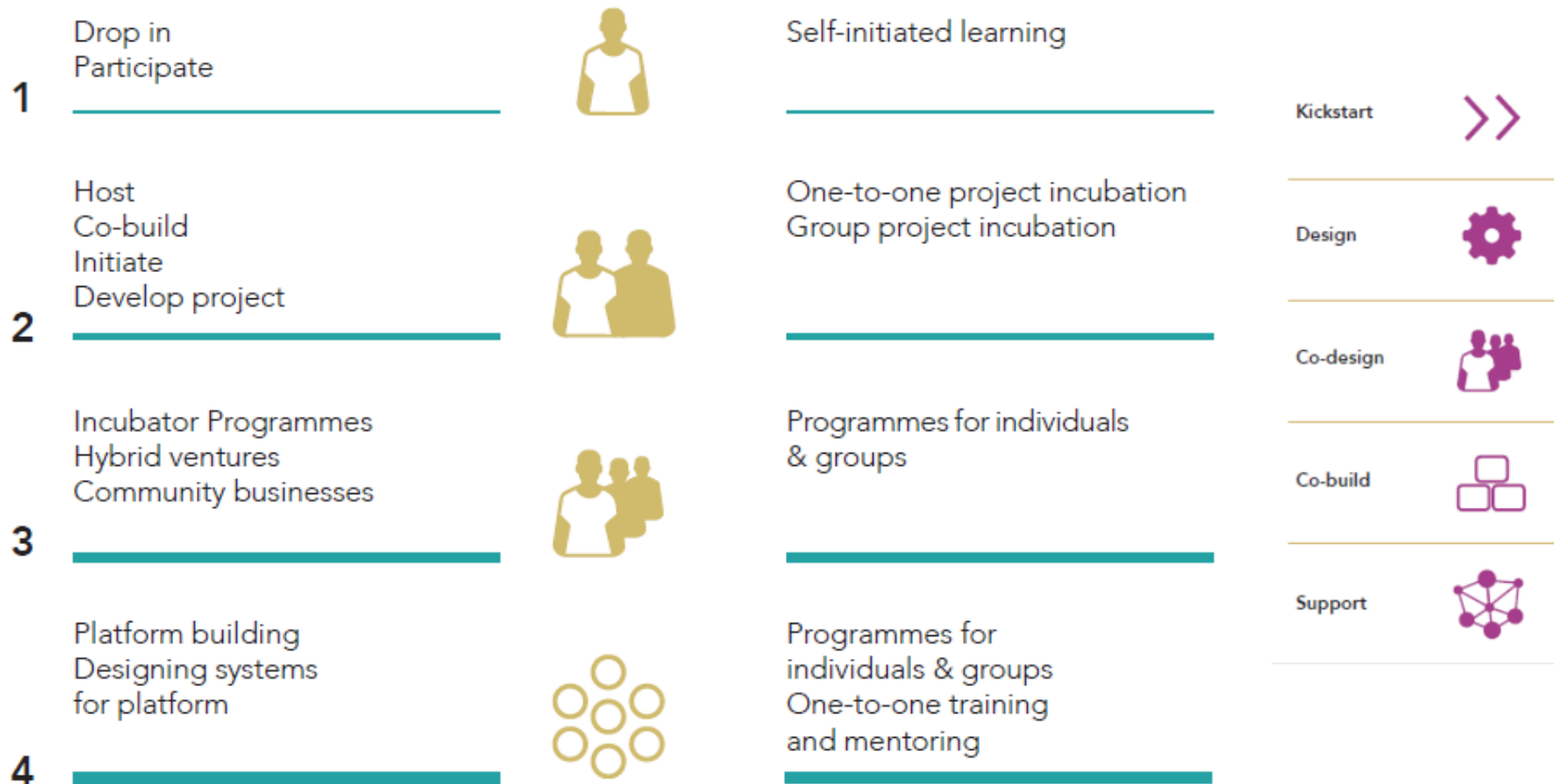

Approach	What if?	Innovations
Integration 	Integrate the offer with other offers	What if services created by citizens were integrated into those by councils?
Inversion 	Turn common practice upside down	What if citizens became the auditors or designers?
Subtraction 	Take something away	What if you could use infrastructure for unhealthy food for the opposite purpose?



Translation 	Translate a practice from another field	What if games could be used to help people stay safe?	Street Pong redesigned walk signals to get people to interact with strangers while keeping them from crossing dangerous interactions
Grafting 	Graft on a practice from another field	What if disused spaces could be turned into places to share?	People United transformed beach huts into innovation hubs for the community, while Phone Book Share repurposed obsolete phone booths into book share
Exaggeration 	Push something to its most extreme expression	What if public services infrastructure could be used by communities to have fun?	Hello Lamppost extends the use of sensors for smart cities as touch points for games, while Edible Bus Stops reimagines bus stops as places to grow vegetation.
