Phil developed and managed the delivery of the award-winning sustainability strategy for the London 2012 Olympic Games and Paralympic Games, widely regarded as the most sustainable Games in modern Olympic history and heavily influenced the International Olympic Committee (IOC's) Olympic Agenda 2020. More recently, Phil has been supporting some of the world's best-known companies such as Kingfisher plc and Marks and Spencer plc to create more business value through sustainability.

Acting in a non-executive capacity, he is on the Board's of Julie's Bicycle (a leading sustainability charity working with the music, theatre and creative industries) and Resource Futures (an employee-owned, non-profit with a 25-year heritage of promoting sustainable resource management).
