



**Trevor Graham, Head of Sustainable Development,
City of Malmö, Sweden**

Trevor Graham is Head of the Sustainable Unit in the City of Malmö working with sustainable urban development through a wide range of projects and strategic initiatives. He has previously worked with urban sustainability and sustainable building in the UK and Germany and came to Malmö in 1998 to head the Eco-City Augustenborg initiative, Europe's most ambitious sustainable urban regeneration programme. The Augustenborg initiative has been heralded as a pioneer in new approaches to sustainable urban drainage. Current work includes developing plans for large scale regeneration programmes in Malmö incorporating innovation and sustainable economic development as key parameters to speed up the process towards the sustainable city. Trevor Graham is also CEO of the Scandinavian Green Roof Institute and a board member of both the European Green Roof Federation and the European Sustainable Cities and Towns Campaign. Trevor has also led a bilateral programme for knowledge and technology transfer on sustainable construction between the UK and Sweden.
