Tomoo's main tasks at the CSCP include the development of sustainable consumption and production policies and innovation tools for policy makers and businesses, the exploration of options to improve the product value chain and to encourage consumers to make conscious choices, research in the field of scaling up sustainable design, architecture and spatial planning initiatives, etc. His past experiences include benchmarking and advising on corporate accountability and sustainability reporting as well as the development of corporate social responsibility (CSR) strategies and the co-ordination of stakeholder engagement for major companies.

Before joining the CSCP, he worked as a programme manager at the Global Reporting Initiative (GRI) between 2002 and 2004.
