Almut Reichel is a project manager on sustainable consumption & production and waste at the European Environment Agency (EEA) in Copenhagen, Denmark. At the EEA, Almut is responsible for analysis, assessments, indicators, policy effectiveness evaluation, as well as capacity building in the above named areas for the EEA's European country network, Eionet. She has written and co-written several EEA reports, including an assessment on consumption and the environment (with Lars Fogh Mortensen), and an assessment of waste policies in 32 European countries. In addition, she has co-organised several stakeholder workshops on sustainable consumption and sustainable business models supporting sustainable lifestyles.

Before joining the EEA in 2007, Almut worked on waste and soil issues for the secretariat of the German Advisory Council for the Environment, on industrial emissions and best available technologies at the German Federal Environmental Agency, and as a project manager on waste management at the consultant company Hessische Industriemüll GmbH in Germany. She is trained as an engineer on environmental technology from the Technical University of Berlin.
