



**Professor. Dr. Wang Yi, Deputy Director-General, Institute of Policy and Management,  
Chinese Academy of Sciences, China**

Professor. Dr. WANG Yi, graduated from Tsinghua University and the University of Chinese Academy of Science (UCAS) and received a Ph.D. of Ecology. He is now Deputy Director-General of the Institute of Policy and Management (IPM) of the Chinese Academy of Sciences (CAS), and Professor of Energy and Environmental Policy at the UCAS. Prof. Wang's current posts include: Team Leader and Chief Scientist, annual "*China Sustainable Development Report (CSDR)*"; Deputy Director, CAS Center for Sustainable Development Research and CAS Climate Change Research Center; Member, Standing Committee of the National People's Congress of China. He has served as a deputy director of the expert group of Chinese Delegation to Rio+20, and Vice Chair of the ISO Climate Change Coordinating Committee. He has been an executive member of some academic societies and senior program adviser to a dozen of international organizations and foundations, including the UNDP, World Bank, WWF China, Energy Foundation, and CCICED Leading Expert Group.

Prof. Wang's research interests include public policy and strategic study related to sustainable development, especially in the fields of green development strategy, indicator system of sustainable development in China, energy and climate change policy, integrated river basin management, and comprehensive planning of development, resource, and the environment. His research has contributed to many of China's current policies and institutional arrangements for environmental protection and green and low carbon development. His masterpieces include the annual *CSDR*, *Towards a Sustainable Asia* series, and *China Study Report* series. He has won several ministerial-level awards, the 4th Chinese Youth Science and Technology Award, and special government allowance by the State Council of China.
