Michal Miedzinski joined the UCL Institute for Sustainable Resources (ISR) as a Senior Research Associate in March 2016. Before moving to ISR, Michal was Principal Consultant Green Economy at Technopolis Group where he led projects and studies on green economy and eco-innovation commissioned by the EU institutions (notably the European Commission and the European Parliament), international organisations (OECD, UNIDO, DCED, ASEIC) as well as by the regional authorities in many countries (e.g. Poland, Italy, France, Turkey). He codesigned and has been a long-standing coordinator (2010-2016) of the European Eco-Innovation Observatory, a pioneering European knowledge and data platform on eco-innovation for policy-makers and business (see www.eco-innovation.eu).

Michal sits on the Advisory Board of Sustainable Innovation conferences and is a member of the Scientific Committee of the World Resource Forum. He has been advising many EU projects focused on eco-innovation (e.g. Eco-Innovera, ECOPOL). He is a regular speaker at international sustainability and innovation events, including EU Green Week and Eco-AP Eco-Innovation Forum.

Michal holds a Ph.D. in Planning from the University of Manchester (2015). He has a Master's degree in Regional Economic Planning from Warsaw University (2001), Master of Arts in European Public Affairs from University of Maastricht and EIPA (2000) and a BA in International Relations from Warsaw University (1998).
