Dr. Niven Huang is the Managing Director of KPMG Sustainability Consulting Co., Ltd., in Taiwan since July of 2013. He is the Regional Leader of KPMG Sustainability Services in Asia Pacific since March of 2018 and the Regional Leader of KPMG ESG Asset Management Services in Asia Pacific since 2019.

He was the Chairman of the 2012-2015 Advisory Board of ASrIA (The Association of Sustainable and Responsible Investment in Asia) which was based in Hong Kong and combined forces with the PRI in October of 2015. Dr. Huang is a pioneer in Taiwan for promoting CSR, sustainability reporting, responsible investment, corporate sustainability strategy and carbon management. Before joining KPMG, he was the Secretary General of the Business Council for Sustainable Development in Taiwan (BCSD-Taiwan) for 16 years and regularly presents on sustainability in Taiwan and internationally. BCSD-Taiwan is affiliated to the World Business Council for Sustainable Development (WBCSD) since December of 1995.

Currently, he is also a part time associate professor of several universities in Taiwan, including the most leading advanced MBA and EMBA at National Cheng Chi University. He sits in the jury panels of several public and private Awards of CSR, Excellence in Environment, and Sustainability in Taiwan and Asia.
