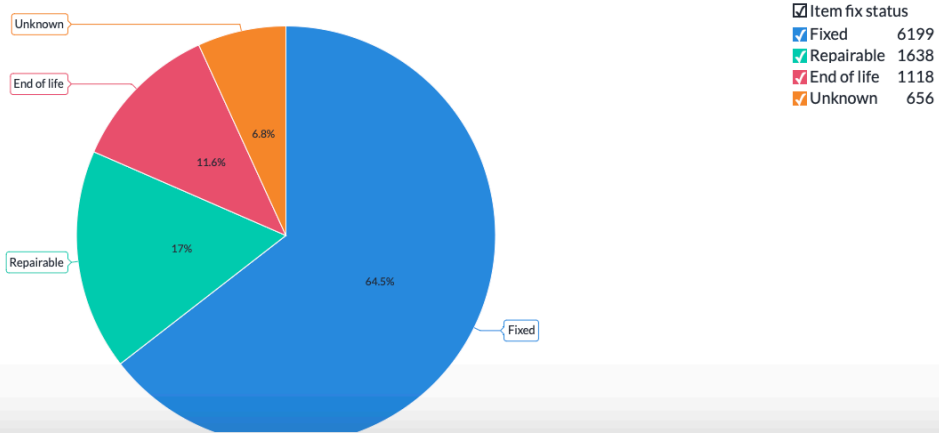

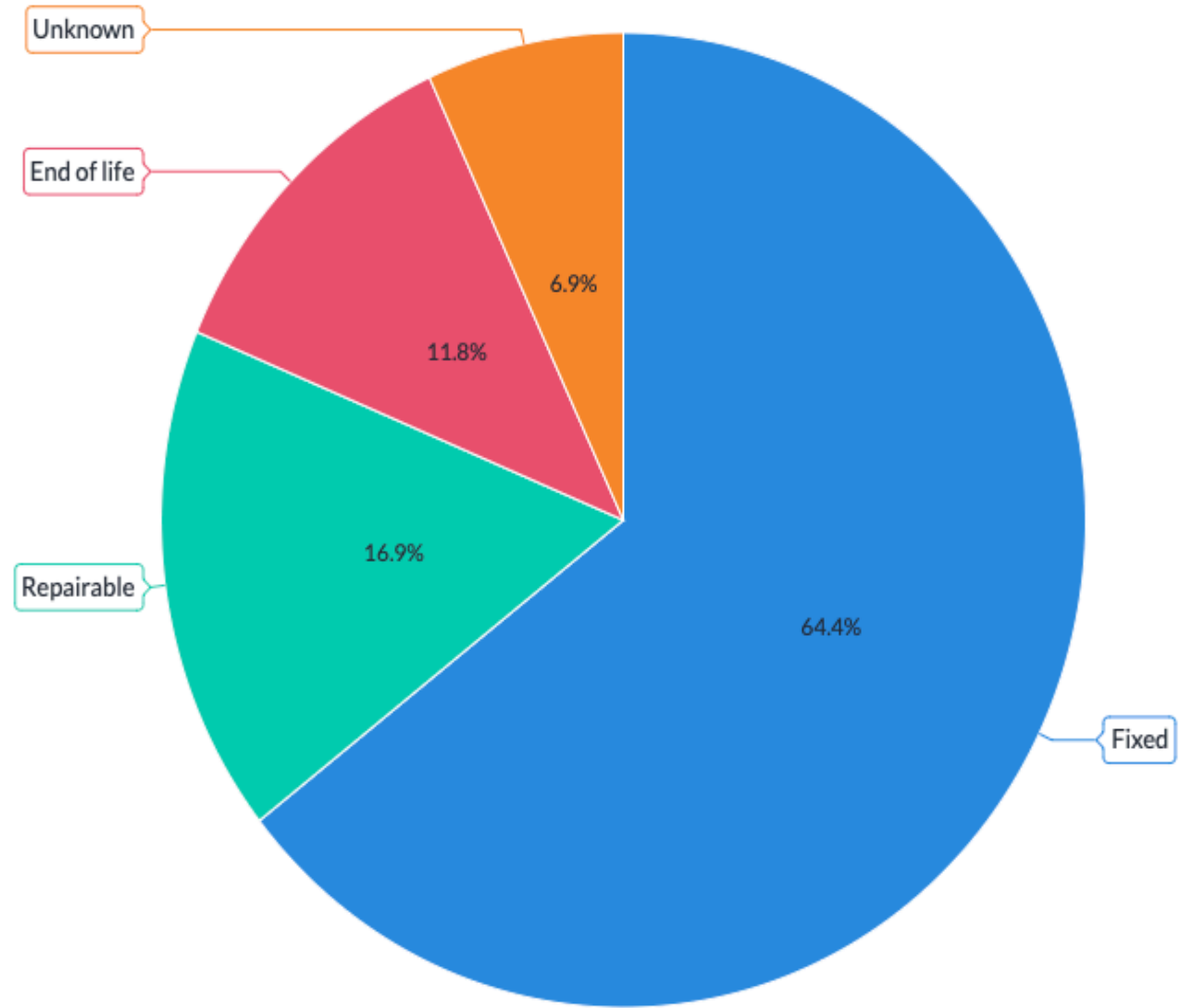

UK Community Repair Network

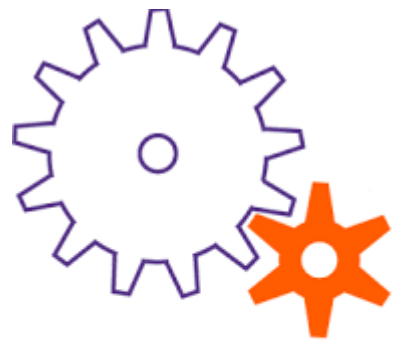
The Community Repair Network emerged from conversations at Fixfest UK 2020 and started as an informal dialogue between various repair groups and local networks during the pandemic.
