Why promoting repair?





65% of consumers currently choose to replace goods instead of repairing them



Discarded goods create **unnecessary waste** of 7.4 million tons per year in the EU

European Repair Information Form

Obligation to repair & inform

Online Platform



European Repair Information Form

Right to request the form from any repairer

Conditions remain valid for 30 days

Standardised information on repair conditions









Producer's obligation to repair



Producers of goods subject to repairability requirements (eco-design)

Obligation to repair goods (e.g. washing machines, dishwashers, *smartphones, tablets*)

Obligation to inform consumers about repair & provide the European Repair Information Form

For free or for a price



To the extent and for the duration set out by eco-design requirements
