**Professor Mattias Lindahl, Professor in EcoDesign and Ph.D. in Machine Design**  
**Environmental Technology and Management**

Professor Mattias Lindahl is an internationally renowned expert in Circular Economy (CE), EcoDesign, and Product-Service Systems (PSS). With over 25 years of experience, he has been a leading researcher and educator in EcoDesign since 1997 and in Integrated Product-Service Engineering (IPSE) since 1999. Since 2003, he has held a professorship at the Division of Environmental Technology and Management at Linköping University (LiU), a globally recognized institution in CE and PSS research.

Lindahl's work focuses on sustainable product development, emphasizing CE, EcoDesign, and IPSE. He has led numerous collaborative research projects, including the eight-year Mistra REES program, completed in 2023. Beyond academia, Lindahl actively contributes to international standardization efforts, notably the development of ISO 14006:2020, IEC 62430:2020, and the ISO 59000 series on CE, with key publications in 2024.

Since October 2023, Lindahl has also served as a visiting professor at Luleå University of Technology and supports research initiatives at Malmstens, a division of IEI. From 2022 to 2024, he was a member of Sweden's Government Delegation for Circular Economy. Additionally, Lindahl is an associate editor for the *Journal of Cleaner Production*, a top-tier publication with a 2023 CiteScore of 20.4 and an Impact Factor of 9.7, reflecting his significant impact on the field of sustainable development.
